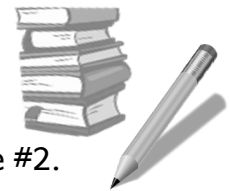


Welcome Back! - Paired Puzzle

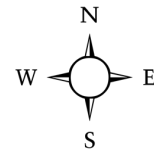
