

TO THE TEACHER

This logic problem is designed to be done together with the teacher reading each clue and eliciting from students what can be colored.

Clue Number 3 presents a clue that cannot be used, so explain to students the concept of skipping a clue and going back to it. Clues 5 and 6 also present clues that must be skipped and returned to.

2. The snowman with the longest scarf has a house with a blue door. Color it.
3. One of the houses has a purple door and one has a green door.
4. The snowman with a red hat has a short scarf and a house with a green door.
5. One snowman has a yellow hat, and his house has a brown chimney.
6. One house has an orange chimney.
7. The snowman with the red hat has a house with a pink chimney.



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
