What does narcissistic mean?

The word *narcissistic* originates from the Greek myth of Narcissus, a beautiful young man who fell in love with his own reflection in a pool of water, signifying an excessive preoccupation with oneself and one's own image, which is now used to describe someone who is excessively self-centered and absorbed with their own needs, often at the expense of others.

Why are these numbers called narcissistic?

They return to themselves!

Are the single-digit numbers 1 through 9 narcissistic?

There are only 4 narcissistic numbers that have 3 digits. 153 is the first one.

The other three narcissistic numbers are between 365 and 410.

Are the single-digit numbers 1 through 9 narcissistic?

Yes. Each has one digit, which becomes the exponent. Each single-digits number raised to the power of 1 equals that number. Each returns to itself. Therefore, they are narcissistic numbers.

There are only 4 narcissistic numbers that have 3 digits. 153 is the first one.

The other three narcissistic numbers are between 365 and 410.

Can you find them? 370, 371, and 407.
