
A Virtual Scavenger Hunt




The White House




Again, this is just a diagram. Read what's in the tan box, then click CONTINUE.

FIRST ADVENTURE: Snow Tubing




Watch the video above

ZOOM OUT


You will eventually see the snow-covered ALPS to the east. Continue to zoom out until you find the MATTERHORN so that you can find what you need.
