Predict how this idea or issue might change in the future.

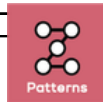


Multiple Perspectives

How might your own point of view change if you lived in another time or place?

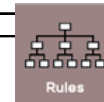


Patterns

How does this pattern help you make predictions or understand cause and effect?

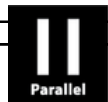
Compare patterns in nature, math, or human behavior- what's similar?

Create a web or map showing all the connections you can think of.

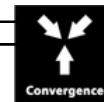


Ethics
